# Roundwood Primary PE and Sport Premium 2015-16



The PE and Sport Premium is designed to help primary schools improve the quality of the PE and sport activities they offer their pupils. The government has committed to funding the primary school Sports Premium up until 2020 – an investment worth £750 million. Roundwood Primary's PE and Sport Premium for 2015/2016 was £9367.

At Roundwood Primary our motto for PE is 'Sport for all'. In 2015-16 all children received two hours of PE teaching from their class teacher and Miss Webber (sports apprentice) each week. Roundwood offers inclusive PE education and encourages all children to meet their full potential. We aim for all the children to be active during their PE lessons and during break and lunchtime. Children have access to a wide range of equipment and activities. Children participate in a wide range of physical activities throughout their schooling including:

Swimming (Year 1)

Outdoor and Adventurous Activities (OAA)

Gymnastics and Dance

Football, Tag Rugby, Lacrosse, Hockey, Netball, Basketball, Cricket, Rounders, Tennis and Volleyball

PE coverage is extended either side of the school day with staff and external providers offering extra-curricular clubs.

The PE and Sport Premium enabled us to employ a designated PE specialist apprentice to assist teachers and team teach alongside them to improve the quality of PE across the school.

Some money was used to update and renew broken and old equipment and use specialists to deliver additional opportunities to pupils during National School Sports Week.
