


Communication and Language

We are learning to listen attentively in a range of situations, accurately anticipating key events and responding to what we hear with relevant comments, questions or actions.

We will use past, present and future forms accurately when talking about events that have happened or are to happen in the future.

Understanding the World

We will look at similarities and differences in relation to places, objects, materials and living things as well as observing animals and plants and explaining why some things occur. We will talk about the changes we see.



EAD

We shall be singing a range of different songs, making music and dancing. We shall experiment with ways to change them.

Different tools and techniques will continue to be explored focusing on colour, design and texture.



Physical

We shall be thinking about the importance of keeping fit and eating a healthy diet. We are continuing to learn to handle equipment and tools effectively, including pencils for writing through participation in handwriting lessons.



In PE we shall be further developing ball skills through a variety of games and activities.

Our Topic is..

How does your garden grow?



Personal, Social and Emotional

We will be learning about relationships and helping others to feel included, and thinking about how to negotiate and solve problems when they occur.

We shall be talking about and preparing for the changes that will happen when we transition into Year 1 and reflecting on our learning in reception.



Mathematics

We shall be consolidating our understanding in matching numerals to quantity through careful counting.

We will be learning to solve problems involving halving and sharing using a range of different resources to support with this.

We will be ordering and sequencing familiar events and measuring time in simple ways.

Literacy

We will be learning to say, hear, read, write letter sounds including digraphs and trigraphs (two/three letters, one sound) as well as more tricky words. We will be learning to apply these sounds to our independent writing of words, labels, captions and sentences as well as extended narratives. Not forgetting our finger spaces, capital letters, full stops, 'WOW!' words (adjectives) and conjunctions (and, but, because).
