Understanding the World

We shall continue to support the children to enhance their learning through the interaction with a range of technology.

We shall be learning about the history of Transport and this learning will underpin and support our visit to Bekonscot.

We shall be talking about and observing changes within different lifecycles eg ducklings and frogspawn.

Expressive Art and Design

We will be continuing to explore a variety of different media, and shall focus on a variety of joining and assembling techniques.

We will be listening and responding to different types of music and playing instruments alongside.

We shall be listening to music from different cultures and explaining how it makes us feel.

Literacy

We will be using our knowledge of phonics to support in reading and writing simple sentences. A selection of animal tales will be read focusing on how the stories are structured into a beginning, middle and end. We shall draw story maps to help sequence stories, and use interesting words to describe the characters and different settings.

Personal, Social and Emotional

We shall be learning to listen to each other and to respond in different ways.

We shall continue to use the Colour Monster to help explain how we are feeling and why we feel that way.



Mathematics

We shall be naming and describing 3D shapes, recalling number bonds to 10 and finding doubles.

We shall be using a variety of resources to support with this.

Physical Development

We shall be children will develop their expressive movement through the topic of 'places'. Children explore space and how to use space safely. They explore traveling actions, shapes and balances. Children choose their own actions in response to a stimulus. They also are given the opportunity to copy, repeat and remember actions. They continue to use counting to help them keep in time with the music. They explore dance through the world around them. They perform to others and begin to provide simple feedback. Our Busy Finger activities will continue to support the development of fine motor skills for handwriting and cutting activities.
