Awarded for behaviours seen linked to our class and school rules. Class treat to be given when they work together to reach a target.

Reception Learning Award

Weekly reward per class nominated by reception teachers linked to the Characteristics of Effective Learning observed during Child-initiated Learning. The child chosen will take home the class mascot.

House Points

Awarded for behaviours linked to our school rules and values. House tokens earned are placed in the visible collection system. Each term, the House with the most tokens wins a special reward and coloured ribbons will be tied to our House Trophy.

Star Tokens

Occasionally, pupils may receive a star token, which can only be awarded by the Headteacher as recognition for truly exceptional moments.

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
