






#### HOW KEY GROUPS IN NURSERY WORKS

### WORKING IN PARTNERSHIP WITH YOU AND YOUR CHILD

- Stay and play session in July, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> 3:30-4pm in Key Groups (one parent to accompany, no siblings)
- Stay and play session 4<sup>th</sup> September in Key Groups (one parent to accompany, no siblings) at allocated times.
- Visit morning with a complimentary lunch, 5<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> September within key groups, without parents
- 8.30 12.00
- Wednesday 10th September all children in Nursery, at staggered times.
- Each child's needs are taken into account and adjustments of timings made if needed
- Information gathered from your forms, home visits and phone calls with their previous setting all help us to get to know your child





#### ATTENDANCE



- Nursery starts at 8:30am, please be prompt
- We try and encourage children to be as independent as possible putting their snack, water bottle and book bag away in group boxes in the morning
- Please name everything, including snacks!
- Please email the office if your child will be absent
- Do not send your child to Nursery for 48 hours after sickness or diarrhoea.






- Afternoons in Forest School!








#### COMMUNICATION

#### 15 Hour code

#### 30 Hour Code

- 8.30 am 11.30 pm x 5 mornings is free
- 11.30 am 12 pm is £3.75 with additional cost of Relish meal
- 12.00 pm -3.00 pm x 5 afternoons is free

#### Without a 30 hour code

- 11.30 pm 12.30 pm lunch club is £6.50 per session with additional cost of Relish
- 12.30 3 pm is £29.00 per session
